Directions: K9 Manners & More training center is at 1000 E Memphis St, Broken Arrow, OK 74012. This is on the northeast corner of Lynn Lane & Memphis. From the Broken Arrow Expressway (highway 51) take the Lynn Lane exit and go south 2 miles. Cross the railroad tracks just south of 81st street and turn left. FYI: Lynn Lane is also called 177th, 9th and 23rd street (hey... it's a Broken Arrow thing)

SITE INFORMATION

The agility trial will be held at K9 Manners & More, an indoor facility with thick rubber agility matting. Parking is available adjacent to the building, and there is plenty of room for indoor crating. **Site will be open from 3-5 PM on Thursday for set up.** Site will open at 7am on trial days. Overnight RV parking is NOT available. Limited parking for RV's during the trial. Agility RV's may stay at the Host Hotel. FOOD: Continental breakfast, lunch and water will be provided for exhibitors & workers. As an alternative, there are several nearby fast food restaurants.

Entry fees: \$25 first entry of each dog (Jr handler \$15)
\$20 each additional entry (same dog) (Jr handler \$10)
(includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee for first entry and \$3 AKC recording fee for subsequent entries of each dog per trial)

All express mail must be able to be left at the Secretary's address with no acceptance signature required. Hand deliveries will not be accepted during the first 24 hours following the trial's opening. **PLEASE do not staple** your check to the entry form. Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations **MUST be received in writing** prior to the May 8, 2019, closing date, be legible and include the AKC number, or no refund will be issued. No telephone changes accepted.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Only qualifying scores are eligible for awards. Rosettes will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class. A green rosette will be awarded for each qualifying score. New Title ribbons will be offered for dogs earning a new title. MACH, PACH, and PAX rosettes and bars will be presented to dogs completing those titles. **If you and your dog are close to a MACH, PACH, or PAX, please notify the trial secretary.** All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the show; none will be mailed.

Special awards, valued at a total of \$400 or more, will be awarded each day:

HIGH IN TRIAL – Regular and Preferred (Master, Excellent, Open, Novice)
HIGH SCORING – Breed Champion, Phalène, and Junior Handler

Awarded to the dog/handler team earning a Double Q in Standard (Preferred) and Jumpers With Weaves (Preferred) with the highest combined YPS (yards per second). If there is no Double Q, the dog with the highest YPS will earn the award. In case of a tie, the dog with the highest YPS in Standard (Preferred) will be the winner.

Any dog/handler teams eligible for high scoring breed champion, phalène, or junior handler must sign up by 10am on the day of each trial.

DRAWING

There will be a daily drawing for raffle baskets. We are asking exhibitors to please donate a prize basket to the raffle. The prize basket could contain dog and people related items or items that represent your state or club. Please bring your donated prize baskets on Friday, the first day of the trial, if possible. Any questions, contact Kay Detampel at 4sheltie1pap@gmail.com. Raffle money raised will help pay for lunches for workers and exhibitors.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: These trials are open to all Papillons 15 months of age or older, that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP or PAL Listing numbers. Dogs with a PAL/ILP or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate. For copies of the Regulations for Agility Trials, or the Dog Show Rules, write AKC, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 276173390 or call (919) 233-9767. The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under 4 months of age are strictly prohibited from the grounds.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Papillon Club of America, Inc., K9 Manners & More, and the Trial Secretary, their agents, members, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Entry fees for bitches that come into season after the closing date will be refunded (minus a \$10 administrative fee per run) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of "Regulations for Agility Trials". A warm up area consisting of a regulation jump will be provided for all exhibitors, who may not use the warm up area to relieve their dogs.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be made on official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

MOVE-UPS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of an agility title earned after closing, however move-up requests must be made in writing and must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than Monday, May 20, 2019, at 6pm. They may be e-mailed to agilitymom@sbchlobal.net. Provide dog's call name, owner's name, original class entered and new class requested. Dogs moved up will generally be placed at the end of the running order.

CONFIRMATIONS: If you provide a valid, legible, unblocked email address, your entries will be acknowledged via email when received. Final confirmation and a judging schedule will also be sent via email—you will NOT receive a confirmation via US mail. If you do not provide an email address, your confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be mailed to the address provided on your entry form. If you have not received a copy of your confirmation five days before the show, please contact the Trial Secretary.

MEASURING: Effective 1-1-2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. Judging will not be held up or interrupted for measuring!

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Handlers of dogs in Regular Classes may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred Classes **MUST** jump in their measured division and are not allowed to jump higher or lower.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
