



Papillon Club of America National Specialty All Around Papillon Challenge (NSAAPC)

This award recognizes those dogs that exemplify true versatility by successfully competing in Conformation and Companion Events at the National Specialty.

Eligibility:

1. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE FOR THIS AWARD A DOG MUST ENTER AND COMPETE IN A **MINIMUM OF 3 EVENTS** OFFERED AT THE NATIONAL SPECIALTY – AGILITY, RALLY, OBEDIENCE AND CONFORMATION (NOT INCLUDING SWEEPSTAKES AND NON-REGULAR CLASSES), ANY COMBINATION IS ACCEPTABLE. DOGS THAT HAVE EARNED TITLES PRIOR TO THE NATIONAL SPECIALTY THAT AWARDED POINTS TOWARDS THE NSAAPC AWARD (CHAMPION, GRAND CHAMPION, TRACKING, CANINE GOOD CITIZEN AND THERAPY DOG) ONLY NEED TO ENTER AND COMPETE IN A **MINIMUM OF 2 EVENTS** (OTHER THAN THE EVENTS THEIR PREVIOUSLY EARNED TITLES ARE IN) OFFERED AT THE NATIONAL SPECIALTY.

2. At least one of the dog's owner's must be a current member of the Papillon Club of America.

All papillons that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration; Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) are eligible to participate. NO, "CANINE PARTNER PROGRAM" (MIX BREEDS DOGS) ARE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.

3. The dog must register for the National Specialty All Around Papillon Challenge award by the closing date listed on the registration form.

Each NSAAPC participant will be responsible for supplying their scores for each event they are entered in, to the designated Companion Events Committee Member to be double checked and tallied. Registration cost: \$10.00
