#### NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veterans Class – Classes for dogs and bitches; 7 years and under 10 years, and 10 years and over. Veterans Note: 1st place winners of Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in any other classes at this show. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may be entered.

Awards of Merit: At the discretion of the Judge, up to five (5) Awards of Merit to be awarded to dogs or bitches competing in this class.

Following Best of Breed Judging there will be competition for: Best Puppy in Puppy Classes - Best Bred By Exhibitor from Bred by Classes- Best Phalene from Open Drop Eared Classes - Best Veteran from Veteran Classes

**AMATEUR-OWNER-HANDLER CLASS** - CHAPTER 3: SECTION 7. The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS** - CHAPTER 3: SECTION 8 The Bred by Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; Not Champions on the date of closing of entries for the show; individually registered with The American Kennel Club as of the date of the show; Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred by Exhibitor clas becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES - OFFERED AT THE NATIONAL ONLY Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

**Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class**; Each entry is allowed at least two but no more than five of their get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

**Brace Class**: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one commone owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

#### **OBEDIENCE & RALLY**

For Papillons only. "Dog" means either sex. Qualifying score required for all awards in Obedience Regular, Preferred & Optional Titling Classes. Qualifying score required for all awards in Rally Classes. Jump Heights MUST be included on all applicable Obedience or Rally classes.

**OBEDIENCE OR RALLY:** A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible. Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers prior to the day of the trial will be accepted. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available. Jump Height in descending order for Obedience & Rally

#### PARADE OF NEW TITLE HOLDERS

Dogs entered in this class may not be entered in a Regular class of this show, however, all dogs must have earned an American Kennel Club Champion of Record Title, Performance Event Title, or Companion Event Title in the prior calendar year along with an AKC Registration Number. The class will not be judged and each entry will receive the special prize of a rosette imprinted with the dog's name. A biography of the dog, up to 200 words MUST be included with the entry form. If entry is on-line, it must be emailed to the Superintendent, identifying the entry by name, registration number, and owner's name. Entry fee \$ 50.00 Enter on ther regular entry form.

# AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY

One combined class will be offered for dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months. There will be a selection of Best of Breed 4 & Under 6 Months puppy, and Best of Opposite Sex. An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for all entries. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler.

A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition.

#### NO PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) MONTHS, EXCEPT THOSE PARTIPATING IN THE 4-6 MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION, MAY BE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

# **IUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - NATIONAL ONLY**

**NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

**NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:** Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233- 9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

#### **SWEEPSTAKES**

Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class." Handlers or Agents may handle in sweepstakes.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog.
- Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a fulltime basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The show giving club, the Show secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
