Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes at Independent Specialties. The winner of each of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Best Of Breed Competition: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be awarded following Best of Breed.

Judge's Award of Merit: Immediately following the Best of Breed competition, the judge may select, at his/her discretion, up to 3 (Regional) or up to 5 (National) of the superior quality specimens from the intersex competition. These would not include those exhibits previously awarded Best of Breed. Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. Select Dog/Bitch or Best of Winners.

Amateur-Owner-Handler: (AOH Class Eligibility) For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show. that are not champions of record. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

Bred-By-Exhibitor Class eligibility: (BBE Class Eligibility) All dogs entered in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC. For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show, that are not champions of record. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. The Person handling the dog must be the person individually registered with American Kennel Club and are owned or co-owned by any of the breeders as of the date of closing entries for this show. The person handling the dog in the class must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. In any subsequent classes for which dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle

Following Best of Breed Judging there will be competition for: Best Puppy in Puppy Classes - Best Bred By Exhibitor from Bred by Classes- Best Phalene from Open Drop Eared and Bred By Exhibitor Drop Ear Classes - Best Veteran from Veteran Classes

Best Puppy Competition: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Regular Puppy Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Competition: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Best Bred-by Exhibitor will be selected from the First-Place Winners of the Dog and Bitch Bred-by-Exhibitor classes, both Puppy & Adult. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED. Best Bred-by Exhibitor receives a prize of one free litter registration, donated by AKC.

Best Phalene Competition (from the Open Drop Eared and Bred By Exhibitor Drop Eared Classes): During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Phalene from the Open Drop Eared and Bred By Exhibitor Drop Eared Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Phalene award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Open class is awarded Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Open Drop Eared class are eligible for Best Phalene competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

Best Veteran Competition: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the Veteran Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Veteran class is awarded Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Veteran class are eligible for Best Veteran competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

POINTS AVAILABLE FOR RESERVE - ALL SHOWS

The Papillon Club of America, Inc. will award a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

The Papillon Club of America, Inc. will award a three-point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES - NATIONAL ONLY

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class. None of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS and BROOD BITCH CLASS: Each entry is allowed at least two but no more than five of their get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

BRACE CLASS: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. <u>Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class</u>. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for addi-tional classes as "Brace Class."

SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

THERE ARE NO RESTICTIONS TO HANDLERS IN SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION.

Sweepstakes winners do not go on to further placement in the shows as a result of participating.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes is open to all Papillons 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. All entries in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Class at the Regular entry fee and on the same entry form at this Specialty show. Champions of record are eligible. Indicate your entry in SWEEPSTAKES including age division in the box marked "Additional Classes.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATION

Puppy Dog, 6 mos. & under 9 mos. Puppy Dog, 9 mos. & under 12 mos. Puppy Bitch, 6 mos. & under 9 mos. Puppy Bitch, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.

Bitch, 12 mos. & under 15 mos.
Bitch, 15 mos. & under 18 mos.

The class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes & Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes open to Papillons who on the day of the show will be at least 7 years of age. Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in any other class. Champions of record are eligible. **Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes.** Indicate your entry in VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES on the entry form in the space provided for Additional Classes. Champions of record are eligible.

The class winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes & Best Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes.

SWEEPSTAKES AND VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES MONEY PRIZES

All entry money in each class will be divided as follows (rounded to the nearest dollar amount). Any undistributed funds revert to the Club.

Thirty-five percent (35%) of total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

First - 50%, Second - 25%, Third - 15%, Fourth - 10%.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

One combined class will be offered for dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months. There will be a selection of Best of Breed 4 & Under 6 Months puppy, and Best of Opposite Sex. An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for all entries. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler.

A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers who are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition.

NO PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) MONTHS, EXCEPT THOSE PARTIPATING IN THE 4-6 MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION, MAY BE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP - NATIONAL ONLY

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:

- Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
 - Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES



The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

- Exhibitors must declare their dog AKC National Owner-Handled Series eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the steward's book and in the show catalog.
- Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit. A current
 assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler
 at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship
 (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Determining Best of Breed/Variety

Breed judging for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series is conducted following Best of Breed judging in each breed ring. All dogs in the BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements in BOB competition. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members of and current assistants to a professional handler, and any exhibitor that did not indicate on their entry that they were eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series to leave the ring and then the judge will then select the Owner-Handled Best of Breed. A dog being "cut" or otherwise "defeated" in the Best of Breed ring remains eligible to compete in the AKC National Owner Handled Series. The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible exhibits based on the program procedures.

If no dog remaining in the ring is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, Owner-Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded.



PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might
 reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other
 than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are
 able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- · Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- · Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- 1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, DogZibit, P. O. Box 2044, Woodinville, WA 98072-2044 by the closing date & time specified in the Premium List. After which time no entries can be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations. Fees must accompany entries; DogZibit assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
- 2. No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, FAX and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are not acceptable. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with this agreement.
